3 Minutes of the last meeting

Due to the introduction of the Triage system and communication to patients from the surgery the minutes of the July meeting had not been circulated and agreed by email.

4 Covid and Flu Vaccination Update

Covid & flu Vaccination clinics are in place and are scheduled for Saturdays in October & November. We cannot start the main covid and flu campaigns until 3rd October 2024

Flu vaccines are being given to children and pregnant women now.

RSV vaccine has started for pregnant woman from 28 weeks.

75 – 79 year olds (plus those that turn 80 since 1/9/24) are also eligible for the RSV vaccine, clinic for this cohort will be after covid and flu campaign. It is not know if this will be an annual vaccine.

9. Triage system

Staying with Balmore Park Surgery the new ANIMA system is not doing too well and therefore not recommended. Patients are saying it takes too long to complete the form.

R B explained that the Boathouse surgery had produced their own questions for the Surgery TRIAGE which will be going live on 30th September 2024. It has been advertised in the village and on Facebook to name a few.

Our main purpose is to prioritise and keep consistent with same GP and reduce waiting times for routine appointments.

MM explained that she was excited about the change and was looking forward to it.

It will be assessed by the Practice and from patient queries. It can be tweaked and edited quite easily as the surgery has produced the questionnaire.

It can only be accessed via our website and not the NHS app.

The receptionist will still be present to answer any questions and to help.
